

REPORTING SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

What every San Jacinto College student should know:

You are **NOT** alone



San Jac is committed to maintaining a safe environment and does not tolerate sexual misconduct in any form. Our trained faculty and staff are here to provide support if you experience sexual misconduct.

What to do if you experience sexual misconduct:

- ✓ **Get to a safe place and call someone.**
 - This can be the police, a counselor, a program advisor, a professor, or a trusted friend.
- ✓ **Preserve the evidence.**
 - Do not wash, shower, bathe, or change clothes before a medical exam or treatment.
 - Bring a change of clothes to the hospital or clinic for after the exam.
 - Keep all emails, text messages, and phone messages. Do not delete or alter them.
 - If you cannot report immediately, place clothing in a paper bag (not plastic). If you have physical injuries, take photographs before cleaning or treating wounds or bruises.
- ✓ **Seek medical attention.**
 - Medical care is important for treating injuries, preventing pregnancy, and addressing STDs.
 - Campus personnel can assist with transportation to a hospital, clinic, or police department.
 - For support during the hospital process, call the Rape Crisis Hotline at 713-528-7273.
- ✓ **Get emotional support.**
 - You do not have to cope alone. Contact our on-campus mental health counselors or the Rape Crisis Hotline for counseling and guidance.

WHAT IS SEX TRAFFICKING?

Sex trafficking is the use of force, fraud, or coercion to exploit someone for commercial sex. Any commercial sex act involving a minor is trafficking—even without force or coercion.

Recognize the warning signs:

- Cannot speak freely or appears coached
- No control over ID or personal documents
- Signs of abuse, fear, or extreme anxiety
- Living in poor or restrictive conditions
